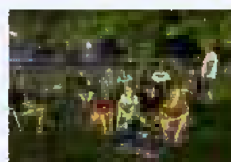
HONEY BROOK LIONS

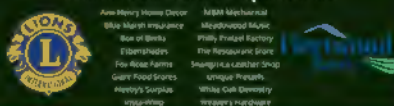

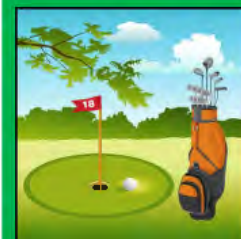
